Its mission is to support talented individuals with great potential and high aspirations in the arts and sciences, especially those who are furthering international cultural collaboration. AMOUNT AVAILABLE: The scholarship will provide \$3000 for one student to attend JASC that may not otherwise have the chance to participate in the conference.
